REGARDING: SCHOOL RE-OPENING PLAN

The 2021-2022 Academic School year is approaching. We hope you have had an enjoyable summer holidays. We are using our new name **Prairie Central Adventist Academy**. We will continue to use the same website until we can finalize our school logo and our colors.

Our school's reopening plan is guided by the Government of Manitoba's Restoring Safe Schools Plan. RRVJA will follow the recommended guidelines to ensure the safety and well-being of our students, staff and families.

The 2021-2022 school year will begin on September 7 & 8 for staff only (no students). The first two school days (September 7th & 8th) are non-instructional days that will be spent by us in finalizing plans for the 2021-2022 school year, i.e. participating in any new COVID-19 related training, reviewing operational routines, and educating staff on public health protocols.

We are planning for students in Kindergarten through 12 to be in class on Thursday, September 9.

Kindergarten to Grade 2 students will be housed at our Satellite Campus located at 2060 Dugald Road (corner of Dugald & Plessis). Grades 3 to 12 students will be housed at the main campus @ 56 Grey Street.

Please read over our reopening plan document carefully as there is detailed information regarding specific procedures and protocols for adjusting to the new normal of school. You will find important information regarding our new drop off/pick up procedures and parking lot use. **It is very important that you familiarize yourself with these procedures before the first day of school.**
